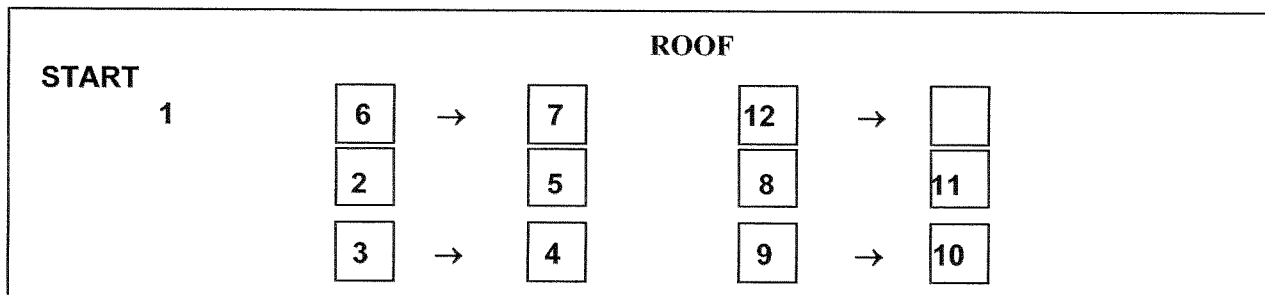

LIFT SCHEDULE

THIS MUST BE COMPLETED AND SHOWN TO THE PILOT FOR APPROVAL, IN ORDER FOR US TO BEGIN WORK.

HELPFUL HINTS:

- A. IDEALLY, BUT NOT ALWAYS PRACTICAL, START WITH LIGHTER UNITS IN ORDER TO GIVE YOUR CREWS A GRADUAL BREAK - IN.
- B. DEVELOP A LIFT SEQUENCE SO THAT YOUR ROOF CREW WILL MOVE THE SHORTEST DISTANCE FROM THE LAST UNIT SET TO THE NEXT UNIT TO BE SET. SEE DIAGRAM BELOW.
- C. NUMBER THE UNIT (ON THE SIDE) AND NUMBER THE CURB (OR FRAME, ETC.) WITH THE SAME NUMBER. PLACE THE NUMBERS ON EACH (UNIT & CURB) SO THAT WHEN THE NUMBERS ARE LINED UP, THE UNIT IS FACING THE PROPER DIRECTION FOR FINAL CONNECTION, ETC.
